Objects:

SCHEDULE and Arrangements

A full academic schedule in consonance with the grades of Public Schools is offered. Also Recitation, art, music and drama are included. Children are allowed to move on in their lessons as soon as they have mastered the principles involved in the new work. This avoids the boredom and lack of interest created by repetition of what is mastered. Self-study, inquiry and research are the natural outcome of this method among bright children.

Tuition is \$50.00 a month plus expense for books, and \$10.00 registration for entering students.
